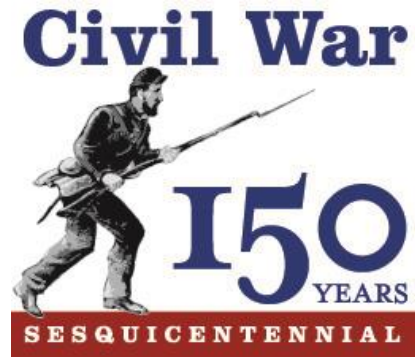

Dec 4 – Union victory at the Battle of Waynesboro, GA.

Dec 5-7 - Union victory at Murfreesboro, TN.

Dec 7-27 – Confederate victory at Ft. Fisher, NC.

Dec 13 – Union Army captures Ft. McAlister.

Dec 15 & 16 – Union victory at the Battle of Nashville, TN.

Dec 20 & 21 – Union victory at the Battle of Saltville, VA.

Dec 21 – Union forces under General Sherman occupy Savannah.

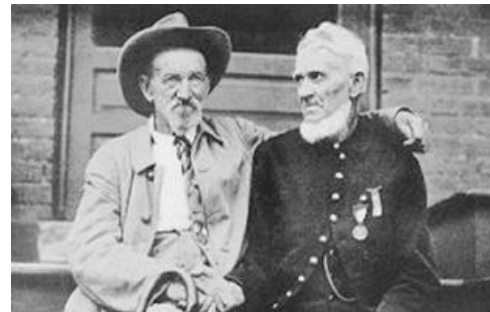

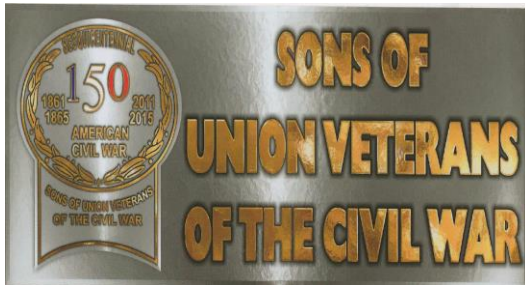
